## ORDER

The Tennessee Commission on Continuing Legal Education and Specialization petitioned the Supreme Court of Tennessee to amend Rule 21, Section 8.03 regarding the timing of attorney payments for CLE credits.

Upon due consideration, the Court hereby amends Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 21 by deleting the existing section 8.03 in its entirety and replacing it with the following new section 8.03:

**8.03.** Attorneys attending approved out of state CLE programs, or other programs for which the sponsor does not report and pay the per-hour fee, shall be responsible for remitting their individual fees at the rate set under \$8.04. This fee shall be paid at the time of, and along with, the report of such hours.

This amendment shall take effect on October 1, 2010.

The Clerk shall provide a copy of this order to LexisNexis and to Thomas Reuters/West. In addition, this order shall be posted on the Tennessee Supreme Court's website.
