AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 67, Chapter 1 and Title 67, Chapter 5, relative to property taxation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-5-212, is amended by substituting the words "is organized as a nonprofit charitable or educational institution" for the following language in subsections (l) and (m):


holds such a license, whether as a transferee, successor, or otherwise, of a license formerly held by the public library board of any county having a metropolitan form of government

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-5-1501(d), is amended by deleting the language "non-prevailing party" and by substituting instead the language "non-prevailing appellant".

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on becoming law, the public welfare requiring it and shall apply to applications pending on the effective date of this act as well as applications received thereafter.


